<u>Greek Drama (Grades 3-5)</u>

LESSON DESCRIPTION

In this lesson, students will explore the stories of the ancient Greeks. After looking at different characteristics of Greek drama, students will perform a Greek myth using masks just like the ancient Greeks. At the end of the lesson, students will create a Greek mask of their own!
